- b. “Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”
- c. The number of global partners we support at Bethlehem.
- d. The good news that Christ Jesus came into the world to save guilty sinners who turn from the deceptions of sin and bank their hope on the One who died in their place. It is the power of God unto salvation for every people group in the world.
- e. The part of the world located between 10 and 40 degrees north of the equator from West Africa to Eastern Japan—a “window” where most of the unreached peoples of the world live and where millions of Christians have focused their prayers for missions in recent years.
- f. Pastor John Piper’s heart-cry for engagement in God-centered world evangelization.
- g. The God-given human means that the Lord of the Harvest uses to call and send and empower his world mission forces.
- h. The price of finishing world evangelization.
- i. Ethnic, language, or cultural groupings of people who have no self-sustaining church. The New Testament word, *nations*, does not refer to political states (like the USA or Canada), but to tribal, cultural or language groupings. To fulfill Jesus’ command to “make disciples of all nations” means reaching each of these groupings and winning worshipers for Christ.
- j. Afshin Ziafat is a Muslim-background believer from Iran and the lead pastor of Providence Church in Frisco, Texas.
- k. The fuel and goal of missions.
- l. October 21 to November 1
- m. The basis of all our hope in world evangelization.
- n. The missionary effort that goes beyond peoples among whom a church has already been planted and penetrates people groups where there is no sustained witness to Christ.
- o. The anniversary Bethlehem will be celebrating in 2021.
- p. A group of people who “hold the ropes” and support a global partner who is on the field.
