# Key Items in Q1 2023

- Annual budget of \$3.15M was approved by the congregation at the January 29, 2023, meeting.
- Successful launch of The North Church on February 1, 2023.
- Operating cash reserves were equally divided at the end of January between Bethlehem and The North Church. Further details on cash balances on a later slide.



# **Considerations & Approach**

 Goal: Provide context and clarity for the Q1 2023 financial update by allocating January 2023 giving and expenses based on the approach below and providing historical comparison to prior years.

#### Considerations:

- 12-month, annual budget was approved for Bethlehem
- DT and North Campus were considered one church for January 2023.
- Prior years were presented at an all-church level vs. by campus.
- Giving is available by campus, dating back to 2014.
- Expenses are available at the campus and all-church levels.

### Approach:

- Giving is presented at the campus level since historically available. Expenses are presented based on 1) direct costs associated to the campus and 2) allocation of all-church costs based on historical percentages.
- This approach was applied for January 2023 and prior years.
- Beginning in February 2023, reporting is no longer combined with other campuses



# Q1 2023 Summary

## Giving was \$593K

Down \$42K when compared to Q1 2022 giving

### Spending was \$700k

Down \$64K when compared to Q1 2022 spending

# Spending exceeded giving by \$107K

In Q1 2022, spending exceeded giving by \$129K







# **Spending History**








# **Combined History**

### Cash Balances as of March 31

Operating Reserves: \$236,000

- Designated Funds: \$664,000
  - Property reserves, short-term missions, women's ministry, helping hand, etc.
- Total Cash: \$900,000
- Other notes:
  - Staff are mindful and carefully stewarding budgets.
  - FPAs are monitoring giving, expenses and cash flow for Bethlehem on a monthly basis.



### **Loan Details**

Prior to the transitions, the loan balance was \$6.8M. Debt was equally divided at each transition point on December 1 (South Cities Church) and February 1 (The North Church).

### Bethlehem Loan Details

- \$2.2M principal balance as of 3/31/23
- Interest rate of 3.2%
- Reduced by \$22.7k YTD
- No outstanding line-of-credit balance
